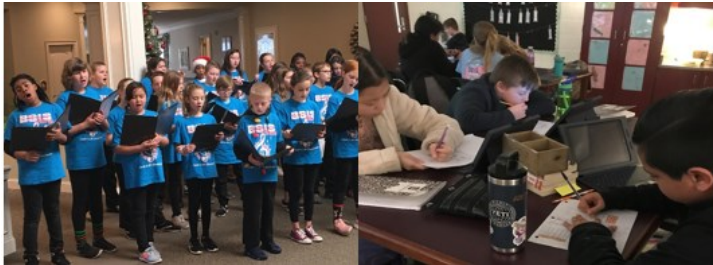


SCPASS - Percentage Scoring "Met" and "Exceeds"
